

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The Mt. Grant General Hospital (MGGH) Financial Assistance Policy (FAP) exists to provide eligible patients partially or fully discounted emergent or medically necessary hospital care. Patients seeking Financial Assistance must apply for the program, which is summarized below.

Eligible Services – Emergent and/or medically necessary healthcare services provided by Mt. Grant General Hospital, Lefa L. Seran, and Mt. Grant Rural Health Clinic.

Mt. Grant General Hospital offers the following payment and discount policies.

- Payment arrangements are available upon request.
- A 50% discount for non-insured patients who are paying their statement balance in full.
- Discount based on income and Federal Poverty Level Guidelines are available for qualified individuals.

How to Apply – Financial Assistance Applications may be obtained/completed/submitted by doing one of the following:

- Obtain an application in person at Mt. Grant General Hospital located at 200 S. A St. Hawthorne, NV 89415.
- Request to have an application mailed to you by calling (775)945-2461.

Determination of Financial Assistance Eligibility – Generally, patients are eligible for financial assistance based on their income level and assets as determined by Federal Poverty Guidelines (FPG) and the patient's ability to pay. Eligible patients will not be charged more for emergencies or other medically necessary care than patients who have insurance. If an individual has sufficient insurance coverage or assets available to pay for care, they may be deemed ineligible for financial assistance.
